**Locate up-to-date contact information for colleagues throughout California, learn about upcoming and archived training opportunities, access resources, and more!**



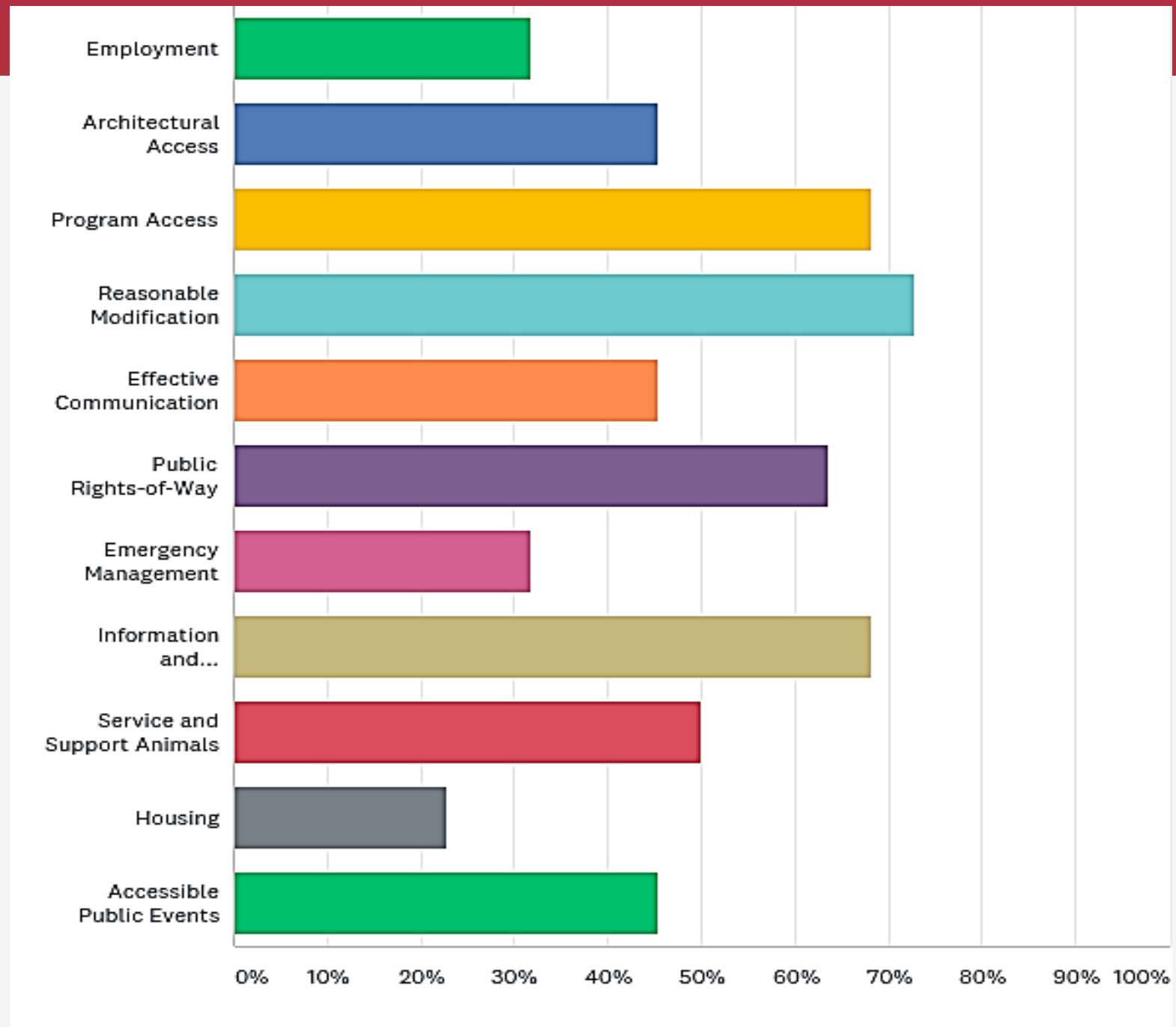
## Networking Events

**Meet up with ADA Coordinators in person for network building and some fun too!! There are two dates already scheduled for this year, in both Northern and Southern California!**



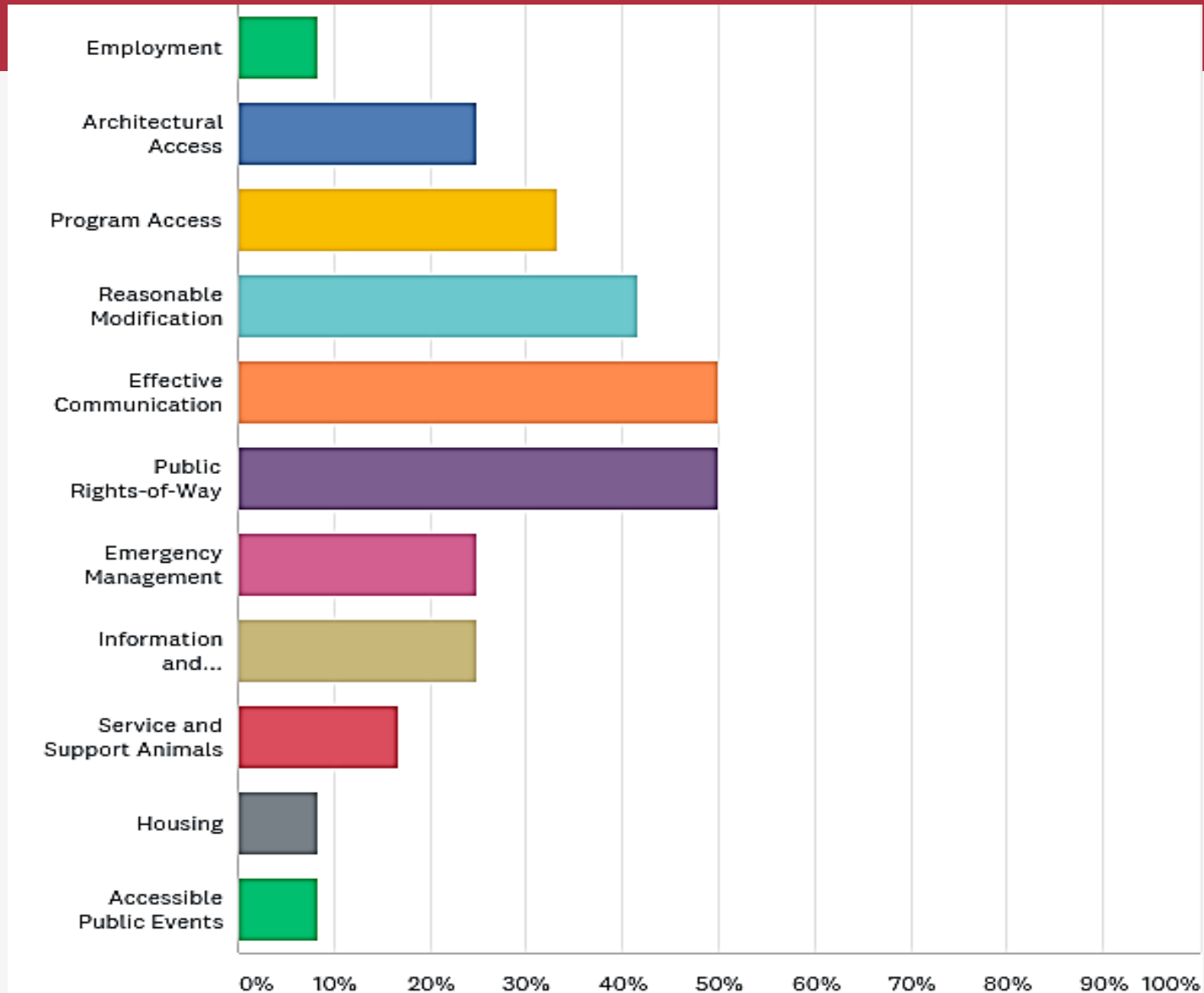

What areas would you like to learn more about?

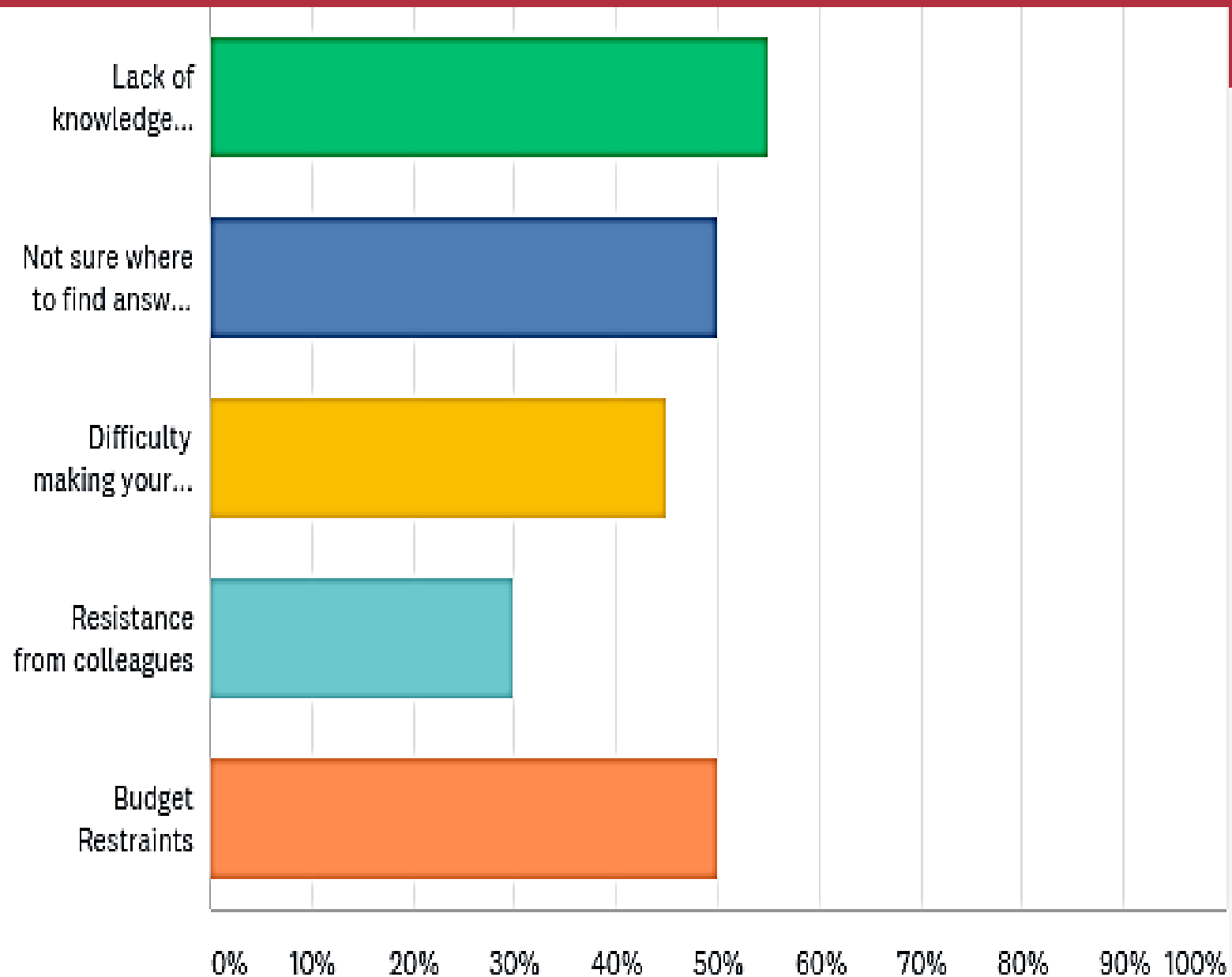

In what areas do you have specific knowledge or expertise that you are willing to share?



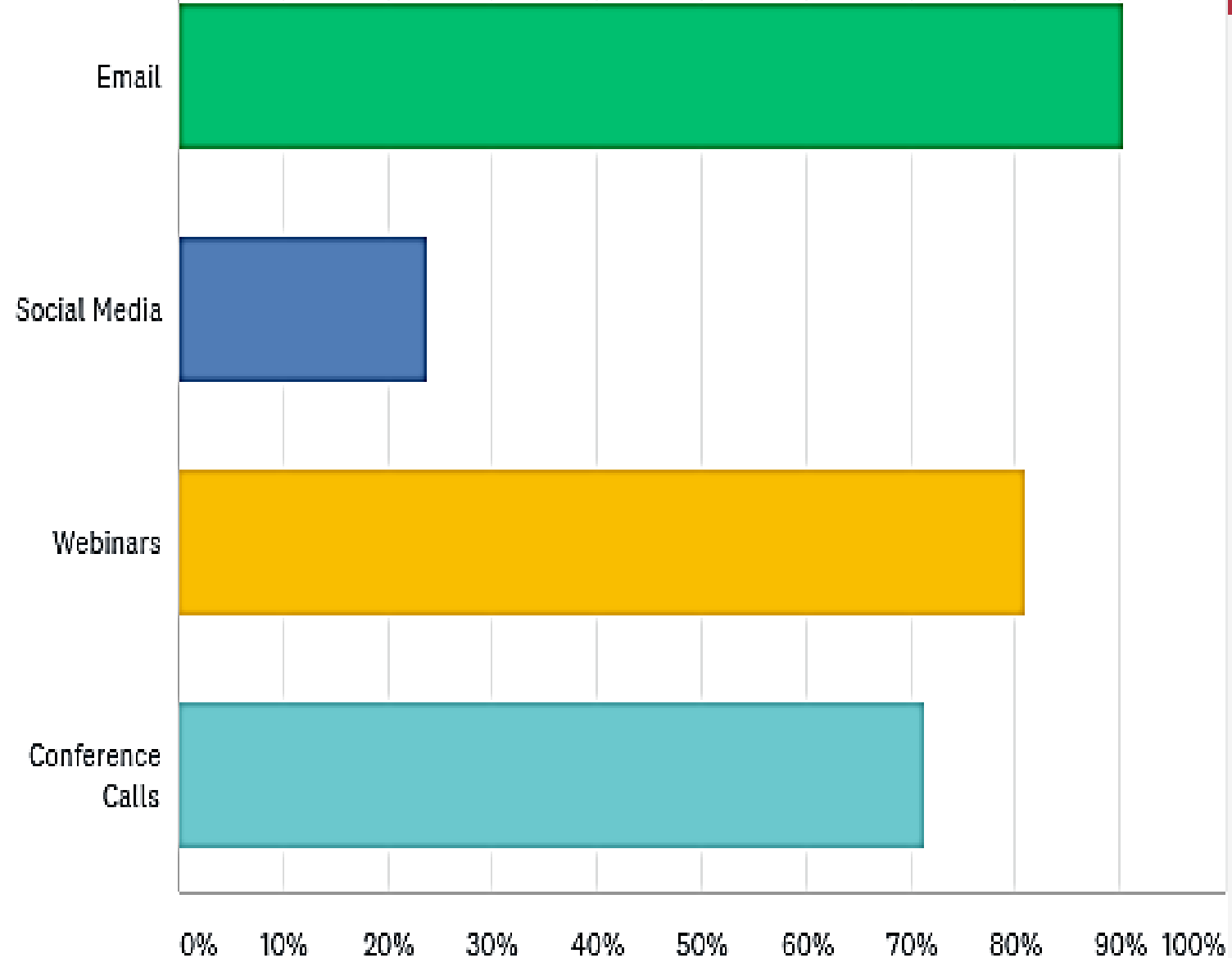
